



Kromski Mazurka Spinning Wheel Unfinished \$375, Finished \$435

The classic look of eastern European wheels of old. The novel wheel-within-a-wheel makes you think of mazurka dancers spinning round and round. The Mazurka design won recognition for Leon Kromski throughout Poland. One look at the detail in this wheels will astound you - what craftsmanship! Made of European alder and birch, the Mazurka features both double drive and scotch tension spinning.

Ratios: 6, 8, 10 and 12 to 1; 2 whorls included. oil impregnated bearings on crank and bobbins; leather bearings on flyer.

Kromski Minstrel Spinning Wheel Unfinished \$399 Finished \$465

A new spinning wheel from the Kromskis of Poland, is going to set new standards for castle style wheels. It features a wide, steady base for the double treadle operation and the wheel, which is larger than many upright wheels - 18". The wheel is easy to mount on the two support posts. The third post will mount an optional distaff.

Larger than the Kromski Mazurka, The Minstrel has stronger, bolder lines and a larger base to accommodate the larger wheel diameter and the double treadles. It is a double drive wheel but comes standard with Scotch tension set-up if your prefer the single drive feel. A threading hook and extra whorl are conveniently stored up front for easy access.

The Minstrel is made of European alder and birch. No Kromski wheel has any plastic parts and as such makes the perfect wheel for re enactors. Easy to assemble.

Kromski Polonaise Spinning Wheel Unfinished \$515, Finished \$575

The look of wheels from the Baltic area of Poland and Scandinavia. In fact, a well known spinning wheel historian has said that the manner in which this wheel is built is as close to being historically correct as he has seen. This will be a plus for spinners wanting the "real thing" and for the growing community of re enactors. The amount of decorative turning on this wheel is substantial, making it a sight to behold. The pictures above and below show a Polonaise with the Kromski mahogany finish. The level of detail and turning is breathtaking. Notice the marbling of the wood grain that is highlighted by the stain and finish. No other wheel being made today comes close to this level of detail. A spinner could pay substantially more for other wheels and still not have the beauty of a Kromski. This wheel is a great value and it spins as well as it looks.

The Polonaise features functional wood threaded wheel angle adjustments so the proper angle

can be obtained with the flyer. "Pin and socket" bearings support the wheel, offering low friction and exceptional ease of treadling. All of the wheel hardware sits between the wheel posts and the footman passes through the bench to the treadle.

The Polonaise is made with European alder and birch and comes standard with double drive and scotch tensioning. Additional specifications:

The Prelude is a single drive wheel. The Prelude is easy to treadle, easy to transport, and has an 18" diameter wheel for excellent ratios. If you like, you can swivel the mother-of-all in line with the bench for a more compact "package" when moving the wheel or for storage.

Kromski Symphony Spinning Wheel Unfinished \$430, Finished \$499

This wheel has the details spinners have come to expect with Kromski products - lots of finely turned wood, attention to detail, and all the features spinners ask for. Start with a good size wheel diameter - 24" - that rotates on bearing sleeves that contribute to effortless treading. The double treadles are well engineered to be comfortable through long spinning sessions. The flyer is double drive but also has Scotch tensioning for single drive use. The bobbins will hold a full 4 oz. of yarn and they fit on all the other Kromski wheels if you start a collection.

The Symphony is made of European alder and birch. Kromski wheel's do not have any plastic parts and as such make the perfect wheel for re enactors.

These tensioned Kates will accommodate most other brands of bobbins including Ashford (standard bobbins), Jensen, Reeves, Timbertops, Majacraft and Lendrum (regular and very fast bobbins).



Kromski Quick Change Flyer Set *Unfinished*

Here is an innovation from the Kromskis that will make changing bobbins on a double drive set-up easier. The spindle on the flyer "breaks" at the base of the flyer allowing you to pull off the flyer and the bobbin without removing the whorl or the drive band from the whorl.

Comes with conversion parts, flyer and three Quick Change bobbins. Requires different bobbins than what is standard with all Kromski wheels. Add \$10 for walnut finish. Extra bobbin \$18 Mazurka or Minstrel \$79 Polonaise or Symphony \$89

The Small Mazurka is a scaled down version of the Mazurka and while it has the look of a working wheel it lacks a functioning flyer. It will not spin yarn. But everything else works - the treadle drives the wheel which in turn spins the flyer, but there is no orifice or working bobbin. This is a great decorative piece and will be enjoyed by spinners and non-spinners. It stands about 24" tall and the wheel is 9.5" in diameter. Available in clear, walnut or mahogany finish.

Kromski Rigid Heddle Loom

The Kromski rigid heddle loom, with several new innovative features. The Kromski Harp has a warping board integral to its design; turn over the loom and you can make your warp (five yards plus). When you get ready to travel, take your Harp with you; it folds to be more compact (with the warp attached) and fits neatly into the Kromski tote bag. The overall look of the Harp is also striking; European alder wood with a clear finish, lots of curves and turned pieces. Folded, the Kromski Harp will store easily or allow you to transport it to workshops, to the cabin in the woods, or to the beach. Kromski Loom comes with a Free video, Loom assembly, warping instruction. 10-dent heddle, 2 stick shuttles, a pick-up stick, threading heddle hook 2 clamps, a warping peg. Warping board and the very helpful "warp helper". Everything to get started weaving, except the yarn.

ADD Heddles to your loom.

DPI: Dents per inch or number of warps per inch.

8 dent use with thick or fuzzy yarns, brushed mohair and worsted weight yarns.

10 dent, use for medium weight yarns, like sport or DK.

12 dent, use for thin warp yarns, fine work. Lace yarn or fine cotton. Not yet available, expected soon.

Add a Harp Stand (a home for your loom and be able to move your loom to a comfortable chair to weave). Add shuttles (You will need a shuttle for each different color used in a weaving)

Harp Stand...For those weavers that do not want to hold their Harp in the traditional manner (back end propped against a table edge) the Kromski now have a beautiful floor stand. All the pieces have been turned so there is shape and contours to everything, making for a striking piece of woodworking. And note some of the features: your warping pegs (these come with the loom) can be used as ledges on either side of the loom to hold shuttles, hold yarn or to keep other supplies handy. The remaining peg can be conveniently stored at the back of the loom. Use the stand for weaving, yes, but also for warping, and for storage (your Harp can be folded on the stand so it takes up less space) **Stand:** 16", \$89. 24" \$93. 32" \$100

Kromski Fiddle Rigid Heddle Loom If you are looking for a basic rigid heddle loom, the Kromski Fiddle will fit the bill. Great for your first try at weaving, for kids and more.

The Fiddle, at 16", will do everything the Harp will do in terms of weaving; you will not be giving up anything in that regard. Weave to your hearts content.

The Fiddle is packaged with a 10-dent heddle, 2 stick shuttles, clamps, a modified Warp Helper, warping peg and a threading hook. The Fiddle also comes ready for use as a warping board (pre-drilled holes on the back of the frame) - Pegs not included. The Fiddle comes unfinished and partially assembled. You may finish the wood but it is not necessary. Assembly is easy and takes about 30 minutes. Add 16" floor stand, \$89

The Kromski story....Life on the western plains of Poland can be hard. In 1918, just after WWI, Leon Kromski began turning wood and soon became his town's spinning wheel fixer. Between the two world wars, prospects were few so in fact Leon did many things to support his family, but turning was something he did well. Before and after WWII, he taught woodturning to his son, also named Leon. Following the second war, life under the communists offered few improvements and the Kromski family struggled as did many to seek success and good fortune. In the '60s, Leon Kromski, the younger, designed a new spinning wheel that won him recognition throughout Poland. His wheel, a first version of the Mazurka, was selected to be sold in government stores that supported Polish folk arts and crafts. However, because they were operating a family business, not a government operation, the Kromskis were held back. They were not allowed to get too ambitious for fear that their woodworking business would prosper and thus they were limited in the number of wheels they could produce. Hard work and persistence eventually paid off however; with the fall of communism and the rise of a free-market in Poland, the Kromskis are finally able to begin to fulfill their dreams. Today, Leon, with his sons Wojciech and Daniel have their sights set on Poland and beyond. With Wojciech's background in forestry and wood products, Daniel's in art and design, this new generation of Polish artisans intends to place their products before people around the world. For today's spinners and weavers, the Kromskis manufacture attractive-looking and well-engineered products and they stand behind each with a five year warranty covering their craftsmanship.

The Kromskis of Wolsztyn, Poland, have been wood turners and wheel workers for three generations. Now, for the first time, their recently re-engineered wheels with characteristic "old world" styling and charm are available outside of Poland. New Voyager is the exclusive distributor of the Kromski spinning products. Combining excellent craftsmanship and features for today's demanding spinners, these wheels and related products are an exceptional value and are sure to become favorites in the spinning community.
