A finely tuned modern wheel that is reasonably priced and meets all the needs of spinners - beginners, those seeking a modern look, Kromski spinners seeking a 2nd or 3rd wheel and those that want the latest innovations that make spinning easy.

A thoroughly modern wheel in every aspect but the concept and design are obviously Kromski. What is not obvious is a new single drive flyer design. The whorl is "changeable" for different speeds; to change the bobbins (all Kromski bobbins fit the Fantasia), the front of the flyer simply pulls off - no drive band to deal with in this adaptation of the original Kromski Quick Change Flyer. Very fast bobbin change. The

wheel and the flyer spin on sealed bearings for an exceptionally soft feel.

Details: wheel diameter - 18"; double treadle. Orifice height - 28"; orifice diameter - 3/8"

3 bobbins - these interchange with any Kromski regular bobbins Single drive with Scotch tension; interchangeable whorls; sliding hooks on flyer, threading hook, attached bobbin holder, oil bottle, elastic drive band.

Ratios, standard - 5 and 8:1; optional - 10 and 14:1, 18 and 20:1

Wood finish choices: unfinished wood and MDF wheel or Finished wood and veneered MDF wheel with contrasting wheel accent piece - walnut on clear or clear on walnut. 13.5 lbs.

It has the look of an antique wheel and the high degree of wood turning that the Kromskis are famous for, but it also has all the touches modern spinners expect. The Prelude is a single drive wheel. The Prelude is easy to treadle, easy to transport, and has an 18" diameter wheel for excellent ratios. If you like, you can swivel the mother-of-all in line with the bench for a more compact "package" when moving the wheel or for storage.

The Prelude is made of European alder and birch and don't have any plastic parts. • wheel diameter - 18" orifice height - 26"; size - 3/8" bobbin size - full 4 oz. • Includes 3 bobbins, threading hook, attached Lazy Kate (bobbin storage), video and bottle of spinning wheel oil. Ratios: 6, 10.5, and 13 to 1 • bearings on wheel shaft, bobbins; leather bearings on flyer.

Kromski Minstrel Spinning Wheel

Features a wide, steady base for the double treadle operation and the wheel, which is larger than many upright wheels - 18". The wheel is easy to mount on the two support posts. The third post will mount an optional distaff.

Larger than the Kromski Mazurka, The Minstrel has stronger, bolder lines and a larger base to accommodate the larger wheel diameter and the double treadles. It is a double drive wheel but comes standard with Scotch tension set-up if you prefer the single drive feel. A threading hook and extra whorl are conveniently stored up front for easy access. The Minstrel is made of European alder and birch. No Kromski wheel has any plastic parts and as such makes the perfect wheel for re enactors.

Easy to assemble. wheel diameter - 18" orifice height - 33"; size - 3/8" Ratios: 6.5, 8.5, 12 and 16 to 1 bearings on wheel crank and bobbins; leather bearings on flyer Includes: Three - 4 oz. bobbins, Video, threading hook, built in bobbin storage and a bottle of spinning wheel oil. Available unfinished or finished with clear, walnut or mahogany.



Kromski Polonaise Spinning Wheel

Unfinished \$625, Clear Finish \$645 Stained \$675

The look of wheels from the Baltic area of Poland and Scandinavia. In fact, a well known spinning wheel historian has said that the manner in which this wheel is built is as close to being historically correct as he has seen. This will be a plus for spinners wanting the "real thing" and for the growing community of re enactors. The amount of decorative turning on this wheel is substantial, making it a sight to behold. The pictures above and below show a Polonaise with the Kromski mahogany finish. The level of detail and turning is breathtaking. Notice the marbling of the wood grain that is highlighted by the stain and finish. No other wheel being made today comes close to this level of detail. A spinner could pay substantially more for other wheels and still not have the beauty of a Kromski. This wheel is a great value and it spins as well as it looks. The Polonaise features functional wood threaded wheel angle adjustments so the proper angle can be obtained with the flyer. "Pin and socket" bearings support the wheel, offering low friction and exceptional ease of treadling. All of the wheel hardware sits between the wheel posts and the footman passes through

Oil impregnated bearings on bobbins and treadle; leather bearings on flyer New wheel purchase includes three - 4 oz. bobbins, video, threading hook, tensioned Lazy Kate and a bottle of spinning wheel oil. Available unfinished or finished with clear, walnut or mahogany finish.



Kromski Sonata Spinning Wheel & Bag

Is a marriage between the classic architecture and design concepts shared with all other Kromski wheels and the functional needs of a wheel that fold's. You get both. It is a full-size spinning wheel that folds and packs away as a small package, making it perfect for traveling, guild and festival gatherings or simply storage when not in use. The Kromskis have put a lot of thought into the Sonata. Full size yet small dimensions when folded, easy to set-up and take down, solid feel, solid

footprint, plenty of foot room, easy treading on double treadles, orifice at a comfortable height and classic looks. Spokes that draw your attention, every piece of wood with cuts, curves and character; this is an appealing spinning wheel that is a pleasure to use. A custom-made, heavily padded bag offers you a convenient way to pack-up your Sonata for travel or storage. Wheel diameter - 19" folded dimensions: 22" by 19" orifice height - 30" . Options Bulky and Fast Flyer.

Bobbin size - full 4 oz.; 3 included; will fit all other Kromski wheels., threading hook, attached Lazy Kate and bottle of spinning wheel oil; uses an elastic drive band

Ratios: 6.7, 12.5, 14 to 1; ball bearings on wheel crank weight - 11.5 lbs



Kromski Symphony Spinning Wheel Unfinished \$550, Finished \$650

This wheel has the details spinners have come to expect with Kromski products - lots of finely turned wood, attention to detail, and all the features spinners ask for. Start with a good size wheel diameter - 24" - that rotates on bearing sleeves that contribute to effortless treading. The double treadles are well engineered to be comfortable through long spinning sessions. The flyer is double drive but also has Scotch tensioning for single drive use. The bobbins will hold a full 4 oz. of yarn and they fit on all the other Kromski

wheels if you start a collection. The Symphony is made of European alder and birch. Kromski wheel's do not have any plastic parts and as such make the perfect wheel for re enactors. • wheel diameter - 24" • orifice height - 27"; size - 3/8" • Ratios: 7.5, 10, 16 and 20 to 1; 2 whorls included • bearings on wheel shaft, bobbins and treadle; leather bearings on flyer New wheel purchase includes 3 - 4 oz. bobbins, video, threading hook, tensioned Lazy Kate, and a bottle of spinning wheel oil. Available unfinished or finished with clear, walnut or mahogany finish.



Kromski Spinning Stool \$95

You need to sit just right to spin comfortably. With the Kromski spinning stool, you can. This sturdy stool has a contoured seat that will let you spin for hours. The legs have been turned so that you can make a permanent adjustment to the seat height from 17" to 18.5". And if not for spinning, you will find this stool works well in a variety of settings.

Kromski Rigid Heddle Loom 16" \$210, 24" \$219, 32" \$239

The Kromski rigid heddle loom, with several new innovative features. The Kromski Harp has a warping board integral to its design; turn over the loom and you can make your warp (five yards plus). When you get ready to travel, take your Harp with you; it folds to be more compact (with the warp attached) and fits neatly into the Kromski tote bag. The overall look of the Harp is also

striking; European alder wood with a clear finish, lots of curves and turned pieces.

Folded, the Kromski Harp will store easily or allow you to transport it to workshops, to the cabin in the woods, or to the beach. Kromski Loom comes with a Free video, Loom assembly, warping instruction. 10-dent heddle, 2 stick shuttles, a pick-up stick, threading heddle hook 2 clamps, a warping board and the very helpful "warp helper". Everything to get started weaving except the yarn. ADD Heddles to your loom.

DPI: Dents per inch or number of warps per inch. 8 dent use with thick or fuzzy yarns, brushed mohair and worsted weight yarns. 10 dent, use for medium weight yarns, like sport or DK. 12 dent, use for thin warp yarns, fine work. Lace yarn or fine cotton. Not yet



available, expected soon. Add a Harp Stand (a home for your loom and be able to move your loom to a comfortable chair to weave). Add shuttles (You will need a shuttle for each different color used in a weaving)

Kromski Rigid Heddle Loom Stand 16", \$105. 24" \$115. 32" \$125

For those weavers that do not want to hold their Harp in the traditional manner (back end propped against a table edge) the Kromski now have a beautiful floor stand. All the pieces have been turned so there is shape and contours to everything, making for a striking piece of woodworking. And note some of the features: your warping pegs (these come with the loom) can be used as ledges on either side of the loom to hold shuttles, hold yarn or to keep other supplies handy. The remaining peg can be conveniently stored at the back of the loom. Use the stand for weaving, yes, but also for warping, and for storage (your Harp can be folded on the stand so it takes up less space)



Kromski Fiddle \$170

If you are looking for a basic rigid heddle loom, the Kromski Fiddle will fit the bill. Great for your first try at weaving, for kids and more. The Fiddle, at 16", will do everything the Harp will do in terms of weaving; you will not be giving up anything in that regard. Weave to your hearts content. The Fiddle is packaged with a 10-dent heddle, 2 stick shuttles, clamps, a modified Warp Helper, warping peg and a threading hook. The Fiddle also comes ready for use as a warping board (pre-drilled holes on the back of the frame) - Pegs not included. The Fiddle comes unfinished and partially assembled.
